

Parental Participation

Roaring Fork Kids is a non-profit center both in legal status and in reality. The true cost of a day in our program is well above the amount we have chosen to charge our families. The cost difference is covered by financial assistance from Kids First, early childhood education grants and our parent participation events.

Each year, Roaring Fork Kids budget includes \$25,000 in parent fundraising dollars. To reach this goal a fundraising committee made up of parents has been established to organize and execute our fundraising events.

Roaring Fork Kids believes that when parents participate they foster a sense of belonging and community and form a school-family partnership that enriches the child's experience as well as the program.

There are many ways to volunteer your time. Following you will find a list of items. Roaring Fork Kids does everything possible to communicate the available opportunities for volunteering. As a participant in our program your family will be required to donate 3 hours per quarter* to the activities attached. If you do not contribute this time your account will be charged \$250.00 per quarter missed. (*January-March; April-June; July-September; October-December).
